

# Hospital Sliding-Scale Care

## Who can get Sliding-Scale Care?

You have a right to “medically necessary” care at ANY hospital in Maine, even if you can’t pay for it. Depending on your household income, you could get that care free of charge, or on a sliding-scale. See our **Hospital Free Care** flyer to see who can get Free Care.

Some hospitals in Maine provide Sliding-Scale Care to individuals and families who make too much money to get Free Care.

## What services can I get?

Usually, Sliding-Scale care at hospitals is for “medically necessary” inpatient and outpatient hospital services. Some hospitals provide other services as well. To find out if a hospital provides additional services, you can contact the hospital Patient Accounts Office (billing office) or the Department of Health & Human Services.



## How do I apply?

Call the hospital and ask for Patient Accounts (billing office), or the hospital’s Free or Sliding-Scale program. They will speak to you about the program, and help you to fill out an application.



## What if my application is denied?

If your application is denied, the hospital will give you a denial letter. If you believe you should have been accepted, you can appeal. To appeal, you must request an administrative fair hearing from the Department of Health and Human Services within 60 days of the date of the denial letter. Your request can be made in writing or over the phone. The request must be made to the Administrative Hearings Unit, DHHS, 32 Blossom Lane, Augusta, ME 04333 or by calling 207-287-3610. If you have a problem with a Sliding-Scale program other than denial of your application, please call the Health Care HelpLine at 1-800-965-7476.

If you believe that the denial is correct, there may be other programs to help. Call the Health Care HelpLine at 1-800-965-7476 for other ideas for help with health care costs.



## How is income calculated?

The hospital may ask you for proof of household income (like check stubs or tax returns). The hospital can usually look at income over the past 12 months OR the the past 3 months. You may qualify if your income is under the limit for EITHER time period. If you do not qualify one way, you may qualify the other way! For example, looking at the last 3 months may help people with higher yearly income if their income dropped in the 3 months before the application.

## Hospitals
